Refresher & Continuation Training

WHY DO THIS COURSE?

Completing formal training is only one aspect of competence. Formal training builds knowledge and skills, but no matter how good it is, it struggles to simulate real-world experience. It is well proven that skills and knowledge deteriorate over time. Ongoing practice helps prevent or slow the loss - but are you practicing correctly and embedding good or poor practice? Annual or biannual facilitated refresher or continuation training can insure that your skills are honed and ready to be appropriately applied when the alarm sounds. And who better to deliver it than those that designed and delivered your formal training?

COURSE OBJECTIVES

The overall objective of all refresher or continuation training is to practice knowledge, skills and experience in a realistic and practical nature.

Training objectives will be set between the host organisation and SARINZ so that we are meeting your needs - after all - you know what you need and what you need to practice.

We will work with you to establish a realistic and meaningful training event that meets your objectives.

OPTIONS

The options for your refresher/continuation training event are only limited by your imagination and your need.

Customised training options we have provided in the past include:

- One or two day refreshers based on any of our formal courses;
- Round-robin training stations for SAREX's or for group, district or regional training days;
- SAREX design and implementation;
- Design and delivery of IMTEX or Paper-Ex for IMT's;
- Customised training events to meet a specific need - eg: Antarctic Rope Rescue, Tracking Selection camps;
- Customised leadership refresher training;
- Bushcraft and Navigation training.

COST

As each training event is customised to meet the needs of those attending, a specific cost cannot be quoted here.

Costs are variable depending on:

- What training is requested;
- What equipment is required to conduct the training;
- The travel and logistics;
- The required tutor/student ratio;

COURSE PROGRAMME

Workshop:

We will discuss any training requirements and/or conduct a training needs analysis in the lead up to your training event. The workshop will be designed to meet the needs as agreed with you and/or your organisation or group. This way you get what you want, when you need it to meet your needs.

PRE-REQUISITES

Ideally those attending continuation training will have completed aspects of the formal training programme. This insures that the refresher is conducted a level that provides some extension for everyone.

Persons that have not completed aspects of the formal training can unduly influence the learning of those attending. Please feel free to discuss any issues with us at the time of enquiry and booking.

PREPARATION

Minimal preparation is required in the lead up to your training event. We strongly recommend you review your formal course notes and put in a little practice prior to your refresher - just so you look good in front of your peers.

WHAT TO BRING

As each training event is customised to meet the needs of those attending a detailed list of what to bring will be provided in the lead up to your training event. As a guide it will be similar to what was required at your formal training event.
